| Description | New Testament Greek II is a continuation of Greek I. It is designed as a course for students who have a 100-word vocabulary, a thorough grasp of the three declensions, the article, adjectives, prepositions, a beginning knowledge of verbs, etc. following chapters 1-16 of the textbook, <i>Basics of Biblical Greek Grammar: Fourth Edition</i> by William Mounce. This part of the two-semester course focuses intensively on the verb and building up vocabulary. What is learned in each lesson is applied to phrases, sentences and eventually longer passages from the easier parts of the Greek New Testament and Septuagint. One of the features of the course is a section in each lesson highlighting how knowing the original language makes a difference in understanding particular texts. |
| Requirements | The main requirements of the course are studying for the weekly vocabulary and grammar quizzes, class participation, and homework in the workbook. Look over the lesson ahead of time and bring your questions! Each Monday lesson will introduce new vocabulary which is best memorized by using flashcards. There is no reading required other than the textbook, no papers, but plenty of oral and written translation (all Greek to English) and exercises. Assessment will include the following factors: class participation, weekly vocabulary and grammar quizzes, and a final oral exam (also translation). |
